



Deleting a Premade Assignment


1. To delete a premade assignment, click **Delete** next to the premade assignment.




2. An overlay message will appear asking you if you are sure you want to delete the premade assignment. Click **Delete** to permanently delete the assignment.



3. Another overlay message will appear confirming that the assignment was deleted. Click \mathbf{OK} to close the overlay.



4. The deleted premade assignment will no longer appear in the assignment list of the Student Set.




Note: If a premade assignment is deleted from a Student Set, it will be permanently deleted. If the Student Set is copied to create a new Student Set, the deleted premade assignment will **not** be included.


However, if a new Student Set is created, the premade assignment will be included in the list of assignments.

Deleting a Custom Assignment


1. To delete a custom assignment, click **Delete** next to the custom assignment.



2. An overlay message will appear asking you if you are sure you want to delete the custom assignment. Click **Delete** to permanently delete the assignment.



3. Another overlay message will appear confirming that the assignment was deleted. Click \mathbf{OK} to close the overlay.



4. The deleted custom assignment will no longer appear in the assignment list of the Student Set.
