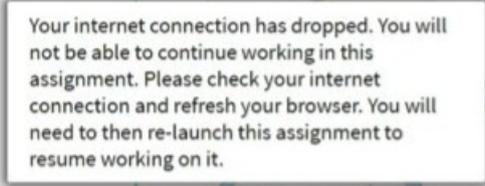


Internet Connection Dropped

If the times aren't in sync, users will be presented with "**Your internet connection has dropped...**" error message when accessing assignment activities such as InQuizitive and ZAPS.
