Windows/Microsoft Edge

Windows/Chrome

Mac/Safari

From the **Safari** menu, select **Settings > Security** tab.

Click the **Enable JavaScript** check box.

Click **Close** and refresh the browser.

iOS/Safari

Go to Settings > Safari > Advanced and toggle to turn on JavaScript.

Open the Chrome app: on your Android phone or tablet.

Tap the three-dot menu icon in the top right corner.

From the menu, select Settings >Advanced

Find and tap on JavaScript.

Toggle the switch: to turn JavaScript on.
