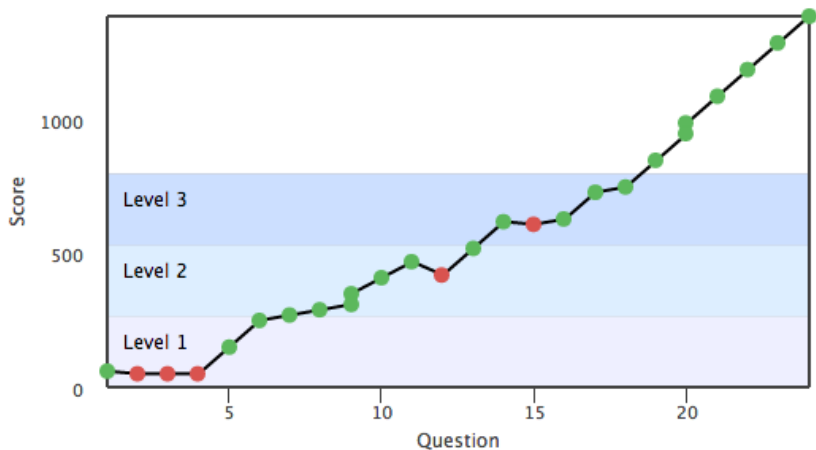

On your activity graph, green dots represent questions answered correctly and red dots represent questions answered incorrectly. You can click on the dots to review the questions.



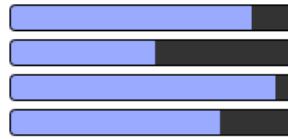
