5. Bloom's Taxonomy

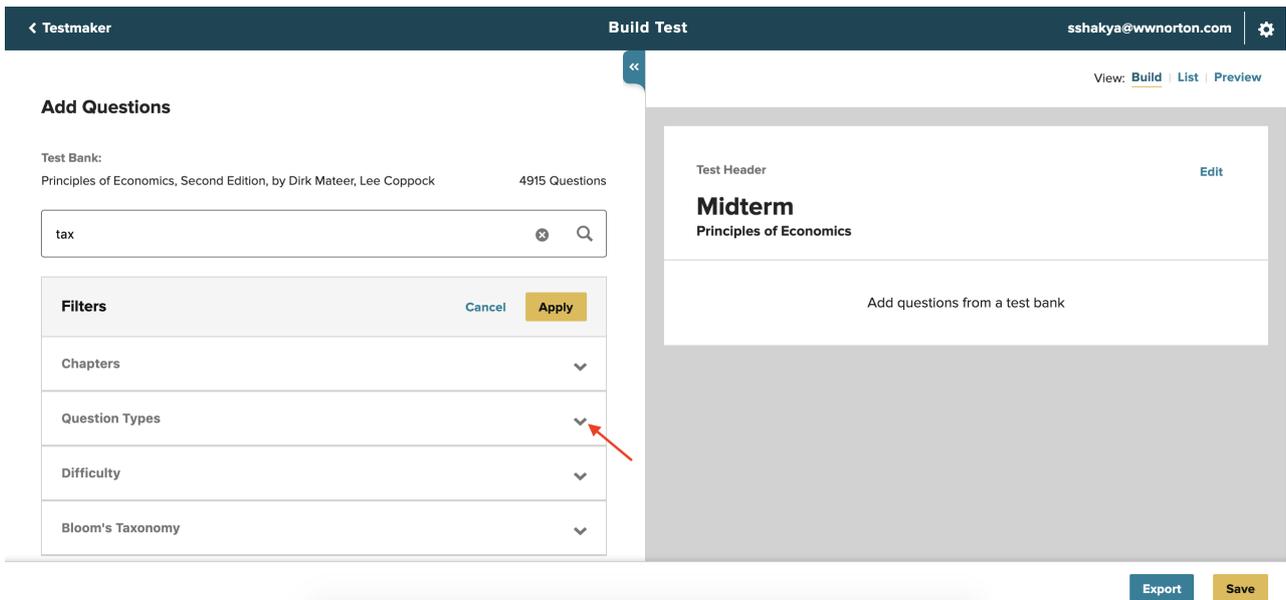
Filtering questions after search result

Questions can be filtered even after a text search.

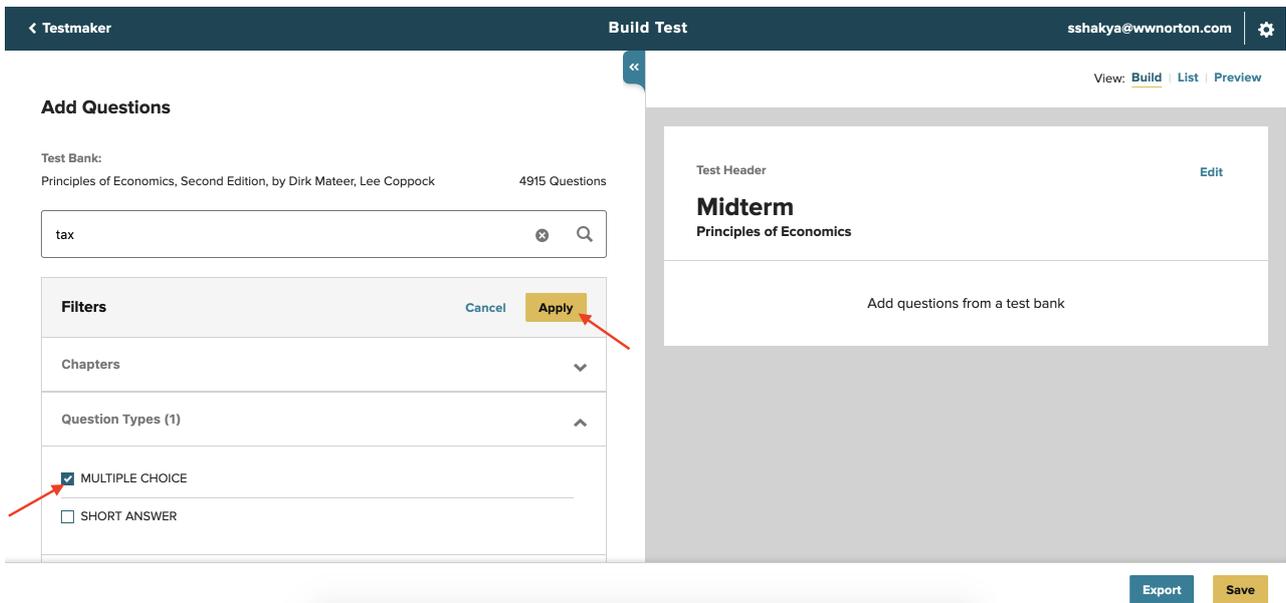
1. Click the "Add Filters" button.
