

# Setting up your Norton course in Canvas through VitalSource



## **Setting up your Norton course:**


1. From Canvas Modules, click on the 3 dots in the upper right, and launch the VitalSource tool



2. You will see the Norton text and courseware that have been paired with your course. Click Open Publisher Tool. If your course pairing is not complete, reach out to your bookstore.



3. Log in using the email and password tied to your Norton account. If you don't have a Norton account yet, reach out to your Norton rep for help.




4. Follow the steps in the wizard to create a Norton course, which is matched to your Canvas course. You'll need to set this up just once per Canvas course.

For assignments, you may set a due date, and adjust the LMS point value




2. Click the Review & Send to LMS button at the bottom of the screen. You'll see a summary of the links you selected. Confirm, and Send to LMS.








### Relaunching deep linking tool:
