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How do I create a Student Set?

This article describes how to create a course student set from a Learning Management System (LMS) course after importing links in the course.

Prerequisites:

You will need a Norton instructor account. If you do not have a Norton instructor account, please visit our [Instructor Resources](#) page, or contact your [Norton representative](#) to request one.

1. Click the Norton learning tool link (e.g., InQuizitive, ZAPS, Smartwork, etc.) you just created, which will launch the tool in a new browser tab.
2. You will be prompted to sign in or register. If you have a Norton account, please use the associated email address and password to sign in. Otherwise, use the No, I need to register... option and register using your school email address. If you have a Norton account and you're unsure of your Norton password, use the "Forgot Your Password?" function below the password field.

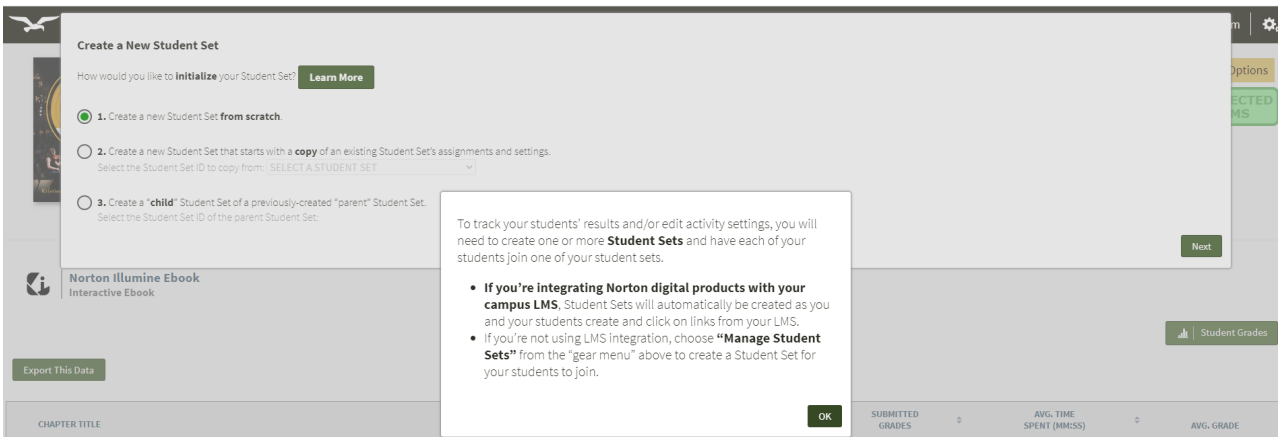

3. The first time you access a Norton digital learning tool from your course, you will be prompted to create a new student set or to copy an existing student set.



4. Select Create a new Student Set from scratch.

5. The title of the Student Set is populated with the LMS course name. Select your state, province, or country; start typing your school's name into the field that appears and select your school from the list; set a start and end date for the Student Set; and finally, click the Create Student Set button.
