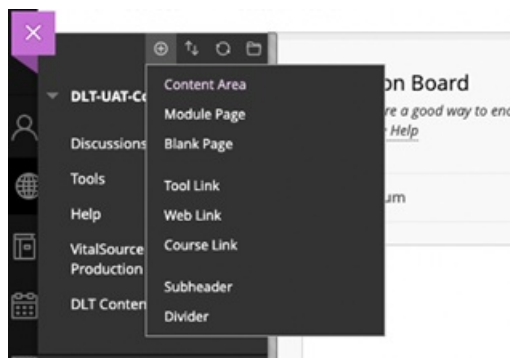


Setting up your Norton course in Blackboard through VitalSource

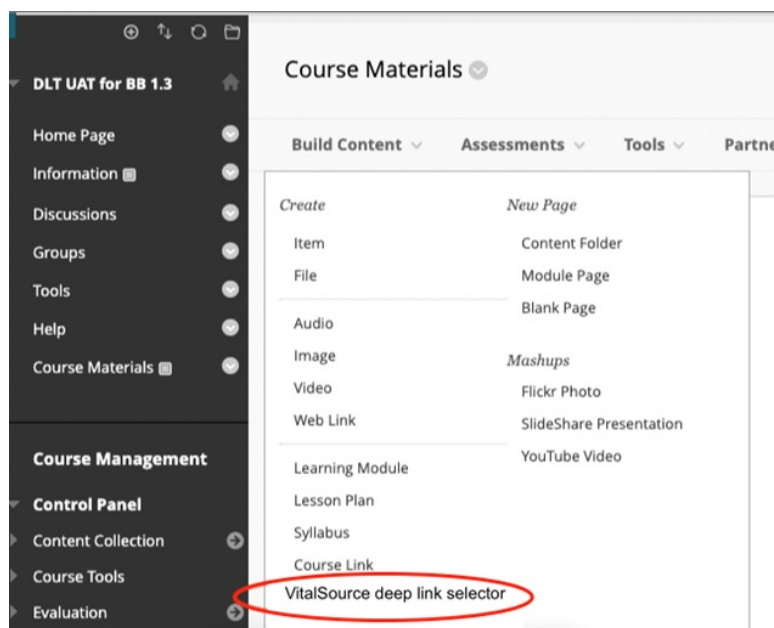

Setting up your Norton course:

1. The deep linking tool is accessed from any Content area in Blackboard. If you don't have any Content areas yet, first add one.

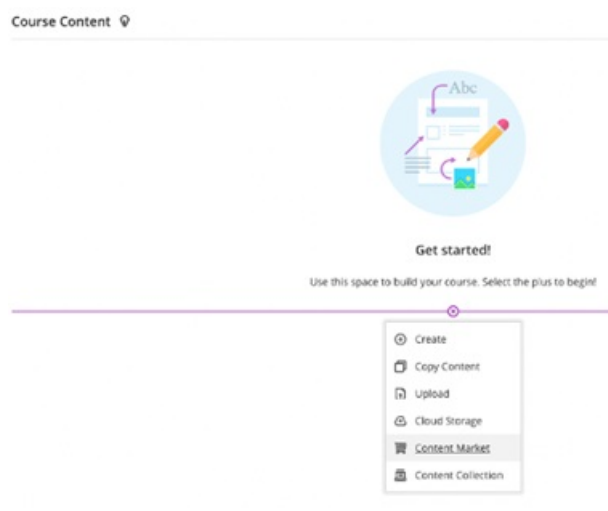


2. Launch the deep linking tool

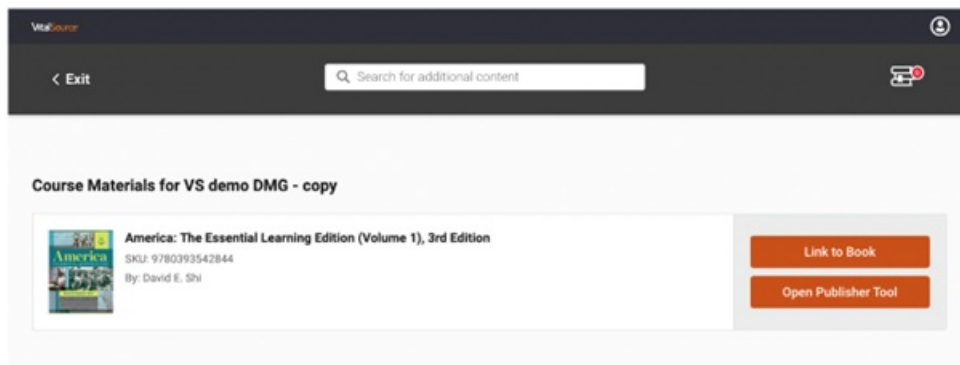


a. In Blackboard Classic/Original View, from any content area click Build Content, and select VitalSource deep link selector (note that the name for the VitalSource Deep Linking tool might vary slightly). b. In Blackboard Ultra View, from any content area click the plus (+) icon, and choose the Content Market. From the Institution Tools section, select VitalSource deep link selector to access VitalSource deep linking.

b. In Blackboard Ultra View, from any content area click the plus (+) icon, and choose the Content Market. From the Institution Tools section, select VitalSource deep link selector to access VitalSource deep linking.



3. You will see the Norton text and courseware that have been paired with your course. Click Open Publisher Tool. If your course pairing is not complete, reach out to your bookstore.



4. Log in using the email and password tied to your Norton account. If you don't have a Norton account yet, reach out to your Norton rep for help.

2. Click the **Review & Send to LMS** button at the bottom of the screen. You'll see a summary of the links you selected. Confirm, and Send to LMS.

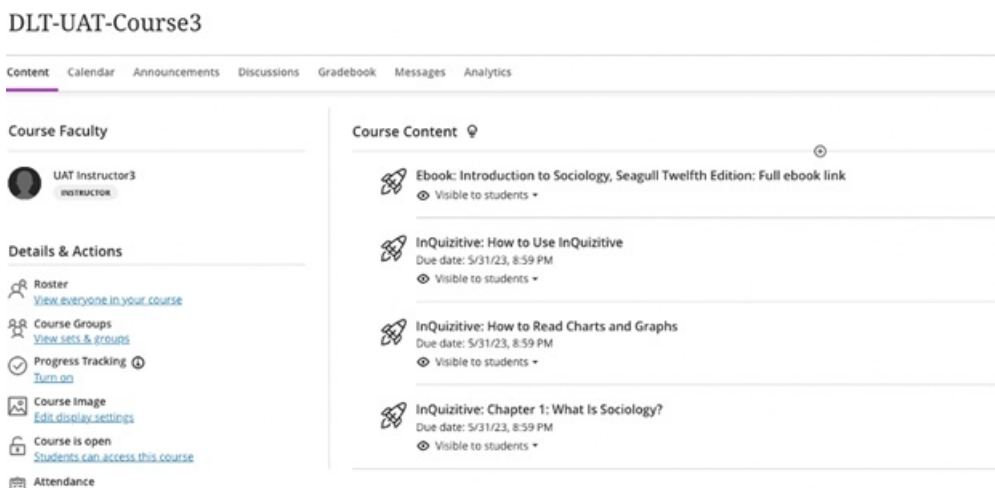


3. When complete, the modal will close, and you will see the content in your Blackboard course. You can reorganize or regroup your content in Blackboard so that your course is laid out the way you want.

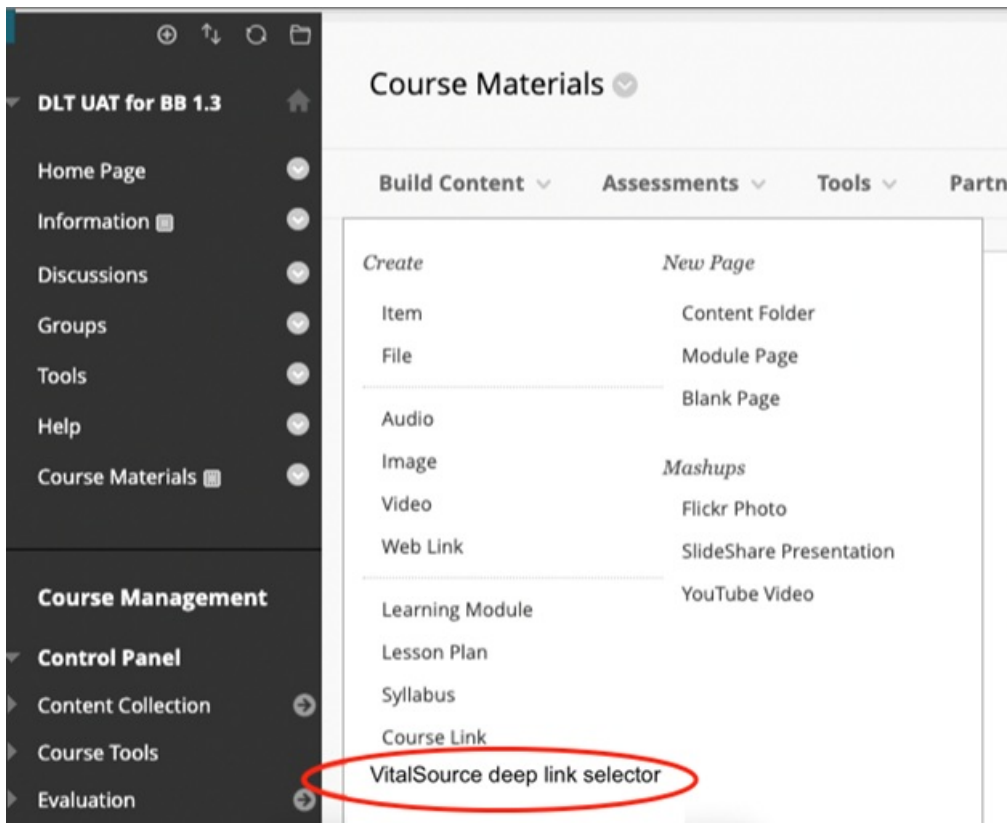

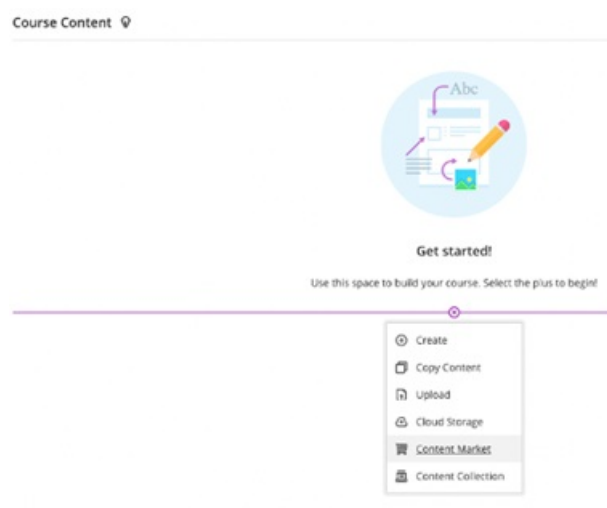
Relaunching deep linking tool:

You don't have to select all your links at once. You can launch this tool from your Blackboard course to add additional links throughout the semester.

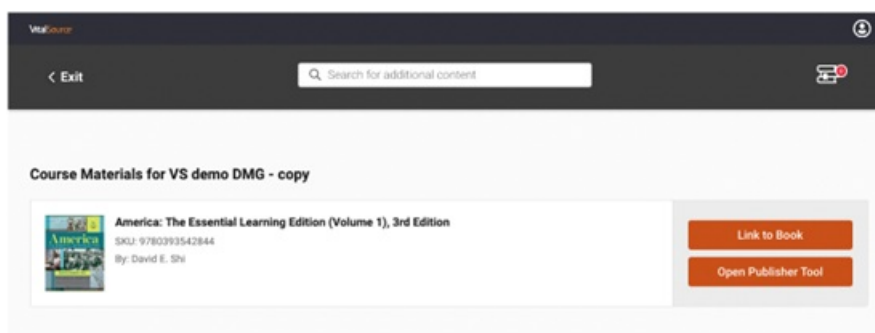
1. From Blackboard Modules, relaunch the deep linking tool.


