

Setting up your Norton course in D2L/Brightspace through VitalSource

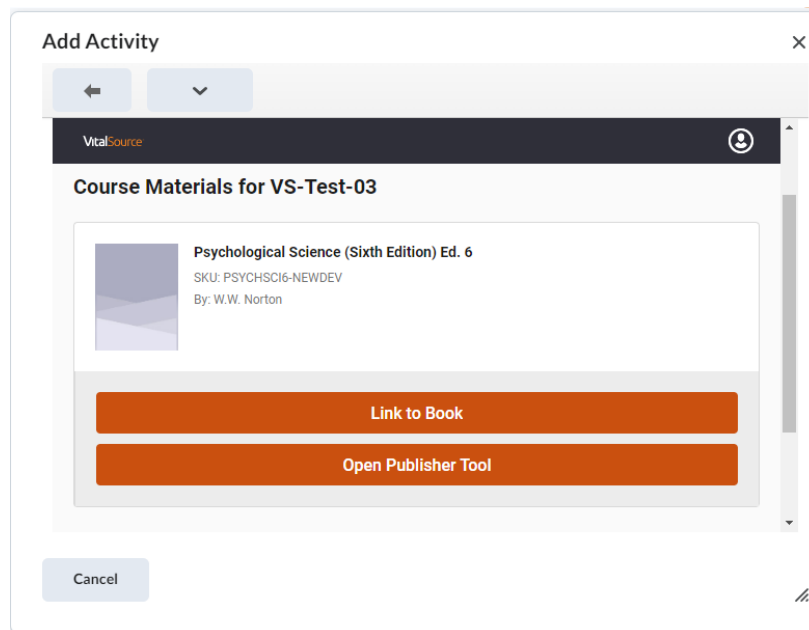

Step 1: Setting up your Norton course

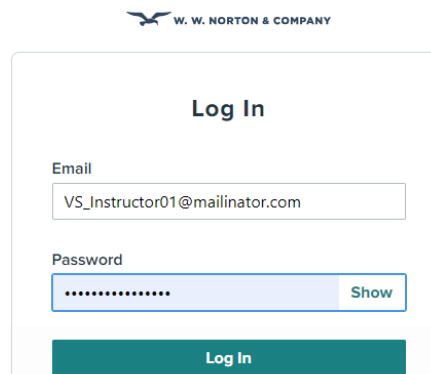
1. From the D2L/Brightspace course, add a module to the course where you can add links. From the module, click on Add Existing Activities and select "VitalSource Content Links" from the drop down menu. (Note that the name for the VitalSource Content tool may vary.)

5. Log in using the email and password tied to your Norton account. If you don't have a Norton account yet, reach out to your [Norton rep](#) for help.



6. Follow the steps in the wizard to create a Norton course, which is matched to your D2L/Brightspace course. You'll need to set this up just once per D2L course
 - a. Step 1. This step confirms that you're connected with your D2L/Brightspace course

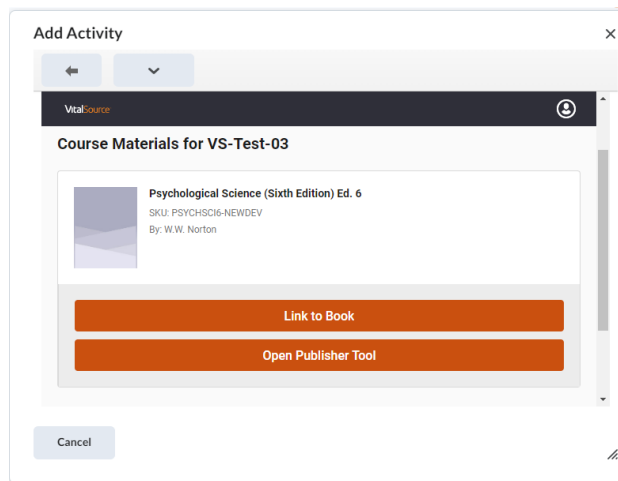
Step 3: Relaunching deep linking tool

1. From a D2L/Brightspace Module, click on Add Existing Activities from the module and select "VitalSource Content Links" from the drop down menu. (Note that the name for the VitalSource Content tool may vary.)
